### SUBJECT: FACULTY WORKLOAD ASSIGNMENT – Spring 2009

<u>DEADLINES</u> - The Faculty Workload Assignments for Spring 2009 are available for review. The initial Spring 2009 FWA should be completed by 5 p.m. on Friday, January 23, 2009. You will receive an FWA report on Monday, January 26, 2009. I have already scheduled meetings with each division chair during the week of February 2 to review the FWA for the division and will be set up to make any necessary corrections at that time. All corrections must be made by Friday, February 6, 2009. The FWA will go to Payroll on Wednesday, February 11, 2009.

**<u>REMINDER</u>** - The FWA Manual was designed to help you in this process.

**Instructor Loads** - The instructor loads have been reset to the load tied to the course e.g., any instructor loads that were adjusted last spring have been reset. The long-standing practice of awarding one load-hour for one lecture hour and .5-load-hour for one laboratory hour assignment should be followed when calculating FWA except with permission by the Vice President and Dean of Instruction. **REMINDER:** <u>The overload course(s) need to be designated on the FASC screen</u>. Use the drag down arrow in the "Teaching Assignment" column and select O – Overload Course for the designated course(s).

**Faculty Assignments** – Begin working on assignments for unassigned classes, changes in faculty assignments, changes in course loads and Special Assignments. These changes should be made by the divisions and departments, not by the Registrar's Office.
