

## **CHECKLIST OF DOCUMENTS TO APPLY FOR TEXAS BENEFITS**

You must give the assistance office **copies** of documents that verify the information on your application. **You can ask the assistance office for help with getting these documents.** You will also need these documents to complete your application with The Benefit Bank. Household members who do not have a SSN should begin applying for one though the Social Security Administration. You can call the SSA at 1-800-772-1213 or visit them on the web at www.SSA.gov. *Also see: Proof of Citizenship and Identity\_for Medical Assistance document.*
