- 1. Print out the application. Look over all the information to make sure it is correct.

- 4. The application and the attached documents are reviewed by a caseworker who may request additional documentation. The caseworker will let you know how soon this information must be provided.
- 5. Within five days of receiving your application, the caseworker may call you to set up an interview appointment at your local HHSC benefits office. You may request a telephone interview if it is a hardship for you or your spouse to attend an in-person interview. For certain benefits, including Children's Medicaid and CHIP, an interview may not be required.
- 6. HHSC will send notice of eligibility within 30 days for SNAP and Medical Assistance benefits, 45 days for CHIP benefits, and 15 working days for CHIP perinatal benefits. A notice will be sent by the next work day if your family is eligible for emergency SNAP benefits.

NOTE: Some children who are eligible for CHIP may have to wait up to 90 days to be enrolled. A child must be uninsured for at least 90 days, unless that child meets an exception to the waiting period (for example, loss of insurance because of a parent's job layoff or loss of CHIP in another state).

7. Re-certification: At the end of your certification period, HHSC will send you information about how you can continue receiving benefits.
