AC has a higher enrollment this year (at this time) than in 2010. Last year we had 99 academic students enrolled before the holiday break and this year we have 190.

The new mobile lab is temporarily being stored at 15th and Progressive Road. An open house for the lab will be on January 13th, 2011 which is the regular scheduled board meeting date.

Process in establishing CNA program this Spring 2011. Classes will be starting in February or March. This will be a 6 week certificate program.

Truck driving classes will begin in June 2011. The cost is estimated to be \$2300 for a CDL. There will be a minimum of 8 students required per class.

AC will be working with the Hereford Senior Citizens Center to start Senior College. We will send the old computers from our learning center to the senior citizens center to be used for learning basic computer skills. Other classes such as acrylic painting may also be offered free or at a minimal charge.
