Tool: YTD results from NR certification examinations are available to the program Director online. The Director will assess the student pass rates annually. This data covers the graduating class of 2008 (May 12, 2008 - May 11, 2009) Standard: 85% of the students will pass the NR exam within one year after graduation	1. 100% (8/8) of the students passed the NR certification exam within one year of graduation.	1. Analysis: Standard was exceeded by 15% with 100% of the students passing the NR exam within one year of graduation. Note: National average for the same time period was 82%. Plan: Continue capstone course in the final semester to better prepare the student for the NR certification examination. Monitor trends for two-year period to identify opportunities for improvement.

2. Guide students to pass the NR certification examination on the first attempt.

2. Tool: YTD results from NR certification examinations are available to the program Director online. The Director will assess the student first attempt pass rates annually. This data covers the graduating class of 2008 (May 12, 2008-May 11, 2009)

Standard:
65% of the students will pass the NR examination on the first attempt.

2. 75 % (6/8) of the students passed the NR certification exam on the first attempt

2. Analysis:
Standard was exceeded by 10% with 75% of the students taking the examination passed on the first attempt.

Note: National average first attempt pass rate was 79% for the same time period.

Plan:
Continue capstone course in the final semester to better prepare the student for the NR certification examination. Adjust standard to 70 %. Monitor trend for two-year period to identify opportunities for improvement
