**Purpose Statement:** To provide co-curricular opportunities for students to enhance their social, organizational, and leadership skills and provide opportunities to engage with the college and community both in and outside of the classroom.

**Goal Statement #1:** Participation in Badger Boot Camp will increase student academic success and retention.

## **Objectives/Outcomes (including assessment tools and standards):**

1a) After attending Badger Boot Camp in the summer, 80% of participants will complete the following fall semester with a GPA of 2.0 or higher.

1b) After attending Badger Boot Camp in the summer, 80% of participants will complete and pass at least 6 hours of course work in the following fall semester.

## **Results:**

2007 – **1a)** N =161, 119=X% of N, **X=73.91** **1b)** N=161, 135=X% of N, **X=83.85%**

2008 – **1a)** N=165, 132=X% of N, **X=80.00%** **1b)** N=165, 129=X% of N, **X=78.18%**

2009 – **1a)** N=207, 154=X% of N, **X=74.4%** **1b)** N=207, 159=X% of N, **X=76.8%**

**(Note: Students who completed BBC but did not register for classes were removed from N. Students who dropped all courses after the beginning of the semester were included in the data as NOT successfully completing.)**

## **Use of Results (including improvements and revisions):**

Analysis: These running results meet our expectations. 2008 FTIC cohort is 64.6% pass rate and 68.6% completion of 7 or more hours. These numbers are considerably lower than those found with the Badger Boot Camp attendees.

Plan of Action: We will continue to hold Badger Boot Camp sessions and encourage more students to register for this activity to complete their New Student Orientation, creating new sessions if necessary.

**Goal Statement #2: Participation in Intramural Sports will increase student retention and ultimately graduation rates.**

**Objectives/Outcomes (including assessment tools and standards):** After participating in Intramural activities, the fall to spring retention rates of the cohort will exceed the overall Amarillo College retention rate by 20%, as reported by the Amarillo College Databook statistics and Datatel reporting.
