Class mean = 75.3 %	1. Analysis: Students exceeded benchmark set by ARC-ST by 5.3%. Plan of Action: Staff will continue to monitor students progress by assessing problems areas in critical thinking and skill demonstrations.
2. Students will demonstrate the technical proficiency in all skills required to fulfill the role as a certified surgical technologist.	2. TOOL: Each student will successfully complete all described summative evaluation tools of clinical performance and pass exit competency upon graduation.  NOTE: Data is for Class of 2010	2. P=90 % I = 10%	2. Analysis: All but one students successfully completed clinical portion of the program. One student will return to complete the clinical portion in the following semester. Plan of Action: Clinical instructors will continue to monitor changes in standards and scope of practice set by AST.

3. Students will meet the professional standards by sitting for the certification exam.

3. TOOL: 75% of students will pass National Certification exam.

3. Analysis: 83% of students of class of 2010 passed National Certification exam as compared to Class of 2009 with exam results of 100%. Data shows a drop in pass rate. These results meet the benchmark set forth by the NBSTSA. National average is 78% as noted on the exam results.  
Plan of Action: Preparation for certification exam will be by using practice exams that simulate the certification exam. Instructor will monitor student progress and apply study material to those who apply.
