LATE REGISTRATION SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION (Diane Brice)

Philosophy behind change – students who register late normally don't do well

Subcommittee Recommendations:

- Registration will end last business day before the semester start day (e.g. classes start on Monday, last day to register would be Friday)
- Students purged on last day to pay would still have time to register and pay as you go
- Classes beginning after the first week of school (block classes) would have a registration deadline of last business day prior to first class meeting
- First two days of classes schedule changes and adds would be allowed

Discussion:

- Enrollments will decline
- Culture shift
 - Should expect completion and retention rates to go up
 - o Focus not on numbers coming in but on numbers going out
- Offer late start courses (3-weeks later)
- May not grow enrollment but could help manage it and help students become more successful

ACTION:

- Diane will take recommendations to Deans Council
- Subcommittee will continue to meet
 - o Consider recommendation to manage Fall & Spring Too classes
 - Get input from advisors
 - Consider leader colleges/WT's policy
 - Get implementation plan in writing
- Work with Ellen's office; marketing the new deadlines
