Program Review

Kara Larkan-Skinner, Danita McAnally and Kristin McDonald-Willey presented information regarding proposed changes for program review in the instructional areas. The current process is no longer effective as we move forward with the Student Success, Achieving the Dream and No Excuses philosophies. Currently, program review is conducted every 5-7 years.

The proposed process would basically eliminate program review and replace it with data from the Key Performance Indicator Report as well as the Kansas Study, student success rates, graduate student survey, licensure rates (as appropriate), faculty work load analysis, CCSSE, employment data, persistence data, completion data, instructional delivery mode, grade distribution, student learning outcomes and qualitative data. The report could be generated every other year during the non-base years.

IE/IR would provide data and program information to each program and the deans, who would review the information together and use the information to develop improvement plans, make budgetary decisions and provide feedback to President's Cabinet. The proposed database and scheduling would be different than those used in the current Program Review process and IE/IR would provide standardized data for all programs. The Dean's Council would replace external review committees and decisions will be made based on data.
