 Achieved a 97% completion rate for the 2011-2012 academic year. One student dropped during the first week of classes due to financial reasons.

 Achieved a 5.9% participation rate for female and 0% participation rate for African-Americans for the 2011-2012 academic year. During the 2010-2011 academic year, we achieved a 5.6% participation rate for African-American and 0% participation rate for female students.

   Our data estimates a 70% placement rate of graduates from the 2010-2011 academic year.
- Analysis
  - O Provide Previous Data/Result Analysis
    (Include if benchmark was met and how results relate to outcome statement):
    Over the past calendar year, 29 graduates from the Basic Fire Academy found fulltime employment in a municipal or rural fire department (26 hired by Amarillo Fire Department, 2 hired by Randall County Fire Department and 1 hired by the Borger Fire Department). We estimate over 83% of our graduates since 2009 are currently working as fulltime firefighters throughout the state. Municipal fire departments require a civil service examination as part of the employment process. It often takes up to 3 years to be hired.
