Purpose Statement (With Last Updated Date): To promote student success by providing tutoring for students currently

enrolled in academic courses (Last Review: Fall 2012)

Adjust instruction and services based on assessment data (AC Strategic Plan through 2015: Strategy 1.1).

Outcome/Objective Statement #1A:

Employees will use institutional data/evidence to determine sustainability and viability based on trend lines for instruction, academic support services, and student services (AC Strategic Plan: Task 1.1.1).

At the end of each year, the Tutoring Dept. will use institutional data/evidence based on usage reports and transcripts to determine whether 70% of students using SMARTHINKING online tutoring successfully complete (with a "C" or better) the course in which they are tutored (No Excuses).

 - o **2010-2011 Data:** Numbers = 159 out of 204 and percentage = 78%
 - o **2011-2012 Data:** Numbers = 153 out of 185 and Percentage = 83%
- Analysis
 - o Benchmark was met and exceeded.
- Improvements
 - List any Improvements Made in the 2011-2012 (Last Academic) Year:
 For fall 2011 and spring/summer 2012, students who used SMARTHINKING were also evaluated to see whether they were retained for the next long semester. (No Excuses)
 - o Evaluate Why Improvements Were Successful/Were Not Successful: 146 out of 185 unique users reenrolled for the next long semester (79%).

2.a. After Tech I and Tech II students work with a professional tutor, 70% will successfully complete the reading course in which they are enrolled as demonstrated by a grade of "C" or higher, based on data collected by the reading department and student transcripts (No Excuses).

- o **2010-2011 Data:** Numbers = 93 out of 145 and Percentage = 64%
- o **2011-2012 Data:** Numbers = 93 out of 133 and Percentage = 70 %

o 2.a. Benchmark was met for the 2011-2012 cohort of tutored students.
