Affiliation Reports	Dr. Byrd thanked everyone for working so hard. Chris Hernandez is now the VA clinical supervisor. Chris reported that everything is good at the VA. Larry Rauscher reported that BSA is in good shape-good students, no complaints. Larry stated he likes the new weekly forms to be able to bring up issues if needed, everything is working well. Marilyn Glidewell reported that students are doing well and are very likable. Deedra Parker reported that everything is great, students doing well and have a good bunch. Director's Report	Tamra Rocsko reported the following: The clinical assistant (Kayla Thomas) is making rounds three days a week-Tuesday, Wednesday & Friday. Tamra is making phone calls to stay in the loop. Program pass rates for Summer 2014 is at 93%. Most are already working and doing well. Graduation rate at 86%. Currently working on self-study and will be requesting information from everyone to complete. Would like to complete by end of December 2014, due date is February 2015. Students are unable to fundraise and use money for their board exams, however they are allowed to fundraise to offset the cost of student trips. 60 hour curriculum- this change is for all AAS (applied associates). No content change, only a reduction in credit hours. Assignments are linked to course objectives to ensure there is no loss of content due to reduction of credit hours. Mark Rowh added that they are reducing clinical hours and increasing lab hours. The representatives viewed the side by side curriculum of the old 72 hour curriculum with the new 60 hour curriculum. Questions raised by Dr. Byrd were: Are general education requirements mandated? Tamara Rocsko responded yes, by accrediting body and Amarillo College. Jerry Moller added that the Southern Association of College & Schools requires that every AAS degree have 15 general education hours. How many levels of college Physics and what are the differences? Jerry responded with 2 levels of Physics, one is an introduction and the other is more detailed. Students can take the introductory physics. Dr. Byrd moved to approve proposed curriculum, Larry Rauscher seconded the motion. The proposed 60 hour curriculum was unanimously accepted by clinical affiliate representatives.
