<u> Greeters Program – Ellen Green/Cara Crowley</u>

As a part of the Culture of Caring, a volunteer greeter program is being implemented on all campuses. The Badger Greeter program will assign staff to stations in two hour blocks from 7am – 7pm the week before classes begin and the first week of classes. 65 people per day are needed on Washington Street campus to cover all stations.
