- **AmTech Program Update**
  - a. **Enrollment**
    - i. Total - 161 students in Automotive, 40 students in Collision

    - i. Trey & Karyn provided more information about the SkillsUSA organization and shared that the District 3 Competition would be held at both Amarillo College East Campus and AmTech Career Academy.
    - ii. We will have a need for judges within the Transportation Industry for the contest. (February 13-14 is the District 3 Contest date)
