#### **SPECIAL MEETING**

The Special Meeting was called to order at 4:02 pm by Mr. Jay Barrett, Chair of the Board of Regents. He welcomed those in attendance. A quorum was present.

#### PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no public comments.

#### **APPROVAL OF THE 2024 TAX RATE**

In accordance with provisions of Section 26.06 of the Texas Property Tax Code, Amarillo College will publish a legal notice on August 18, 2025, stating that the no-new-revenue tax rate for the Amarillo Junior College District for 2025 is \$ 0.20773 per \$100 of assessed value. The voter-approval tax rate for the Amarillo Junior College District for 2025 published in the legal notice is \$ 0.23294 per \$100 of assessed value.

Section 26.05 of the Property Tax Code requires a taxing unit to hold one public hearing on a tax rate. The recommended tax rate is \$ 0.21994.

Mr. Sharp addressed the proposed tax rate with the Board.

Mrs. Carlisle moved that the proposed tax rate not exceed \$0.21994, which will effectively be a 5.87% increase in the tax rate. Mr. Woodburn seconded. Mr. Sharp discussed how the proposed tax rate is calculated. The motion passed unanimously.

### APPROVAL OF THE DATE TO ADOPT THE TAX RATE FOR 2025 AND SCHEDULE A PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING THE TAX RATE FOR 2025

The Board will set the date to adopt the tax rate for 2025, and will schedule one public hearing regarding the tax rate for 2025.

Ms. Thomas moved that we set the date for the public hearing and adoption of the proposed tax rate for August 26, 2025, at 6:00 p.m., on the Washington Street Campus, College Union Building, Second Floor, Palo Duro Room. Mrs. Carlisle seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

#### **ADJOURNMENT**

Mrs. Hughes moved to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Woodburn seconded. The meeting adjourned at 4:12 pm.
