1. 12.12.25 Minutes: The minutes were presented as-is and without comments. A motion was made, seconded, and approved by the Committee.
2. Mass Media Course Change - Removing COMM 2303 as the pre-requisite for RTVB 2343. This will not impact Mass Media students. A motion was made, seconded, and approved by the Committee.
3. Music Course Change - Remove corequisite MUSI-1116 to allow for dual credit MUSI-1311 offerings. A motion was made, seconded, and approved by the Committee.
4. A total of five Film Program Closures and Deactivations:
  - a. Close two programs:
    - i. Film Media Performance AAS (FLMC.AAS.PERF)

- ii. Film Performance Certificate (FLMC.CERT.PERF)
  - b. Deactivate three programs:
    - i. Film Broadcast Media Performance Certificate (RTVB.CERT.BMP)
    - ii. Film Motion Picture Production AAS (FLMC.AAS.PROD)
    - iii. Film Motion Picture Production Certificate (FLMC.CERT.PROD)
- 5. Computer Information Systems Program Revisions
  - a. Program revision and name change for Coding Design and Certificate (COSC.CERT.CODE) name changed to CIS-Applied Systems & Design Certificate. A motion was made, seconded, and approved by the Committee.
  - b. Program revision and name change for Computer Systems Support Certificate (COSC.CERT.CSS) - name changed to CIS-Software Foundations Certificate. A motion was made, seconded, and approved by the Committee.
  - c. Program revision for course changes within the Game Design Certificate (COSC.CERT.GAME). GAME 1328 Video Game Design and GAME 2341 Game Scripting were removed from the program and replaced with GAME 2332 Project Development I. ARTC 1302 Digital Imaging I and ITSE 2321 Object-Oriented Programming were added to the certificate to maintain 18 SCH. A motion was made, seconded, and approved by the Committee.
  - d. Deactivate CIS-Mobile App Development Certificate (ITSE.MKT.APP) The program has three classes, one of which is being deleted from the program. It is not tracked in DAIR. A motion was made, seconded, and approved by the Committee.
  - e. Program revision and name change for Web Developer Specialist Certificate

(COSC.CERT.WEB) - name change to CIS-Web Development Foundations Certificate. A motion was made, seconded, and approved by the Committee.

- f. Program revision for CIS-Software Development Certificate (COSC.CERT.ACAD) - The revised curriculum centers on a scaffolded sequence of Programming Fundamentals I, II, and III, supported by logic and design, object-oriented programming, database programming, and beginning and advanced web development. A motion was made, seconded, and approved by the Committee.
  - g. Program revision of Computer Information Systems AAS (COSC.AAS) re-aligning the program to include pathways to completion for our Level 1 and Level 2 certificates. Additionally, change the name of the IT Track to IT Generalist Track and Computer Science track was renamed to Software Development. Full Stack Development track was removed from the AAS due to lack of enrollment. A motion was made, seconded, and approved by the Committee.
6. Respiratory Care Program Revision - course changes to allow for the addition of BIOL 2402 to the program. Additionally, a fee of \$270 for RSPT 2217. A motion was made, seconded, and approved by the Committee.
  7. Occupational Therapy Program Revision - course changes and addition of fee of \$85 added to OTHA 2330 for NBCOT study pack to prepare graduates.
  8. Welding Program Revision and New Program
    - a. New program - Welding Technology Intermediate Certificate (WLDG.CERT.INT) A motion was made, seconded, and approved by the

Committee.
