Lester, their instructor, keeps them involved in many community service projects. Roach added that she went to Nicaragua with faculty and fellow students. <p>Director’s Report</p>	<p>Cleere introduced Mark Rowh, the new Dean of Health Sciences. Cleere thanked the area dentists and hygienists for their support of the program and attending the advisory meeting. Dr. Harrison is now helping in the clinic and the faculty & students are very glad to have his expertise. The program is preparing for mock boards and thanked the dentists and hygienists for their help. Cleere is teaching Periodontology, Preventive Dental Hygiene Care, Clinical, and Contemporary Dental Hygiene. Once again the clinic will hosts the Central Regional Dental Testing Services (CRDTS) exam May 31 – 6/2 2013. Cleere added that without Stephanie Lindsey-Goldston’s help the clinic would not run as smoothly as it does. <p>Faculty & Staff Report</p>	<p>Dr. Fowler enjoys helping in the clinic and is very proud of the new facilities. Dr. Henderson welcomes all area dentists to help out with mock boards and he too is very proud of the new facilities. Henderson teaches Dental Materials and the students are working on impressions. He added that currently there are 13,000 patients in the clinic database. Collins reported that the students are doing well and that Dr. Harrison is also helping with the Anatomy Lab and as well as assisting in the clinic. Hayhurst reported that the freshmen students are learning the clinical aspects and will start working on live patients real soon. Lester reported that the mock boards are geared exactly like the real board exam and the whole process is incredibly calibrated. There are staff meetings every Thursday to discuss issues at hand and that keeps the faculty and staff united. They also have monthly staff meetings. Some of the community projects that have taken place: After School Programs; Tyler Street; Great American Smoke-Out at Westgate Mall; Head Start Health Fair; Homeless Health Fair; WTAMU Health Fair; and Mission of Mercy 2012.
