He reminded everyone that it is the responsibility of the student to give their "weekly" to them. He also thanked Alan Kinzer, from the VA Hospital, for their donation of the body phantom that is being used in lab. Fast-tracking/alternative methods will no longer be offered after 2015 according to the NMTCB. Rowh asked the committee what they thought of having the second year students graduating in May instead walking the stage in May and then returning to class for the summer. It would allow for the students to have a review session for 16 weeks vs. 9 weeks.
