Director Report	Donna Cleere reported they are having a great semester and appreciates the dental community for all of their support. Currently there are 26 sophomores, and 29 freshmen. Changed grading system to TalEval, a national software program. It was implemented in the Fall semester. The TalEval serves as the ultimate tool for assisting faculty in demonstrating compliance with CODA standards. Cleere feels very fortunate to be using this software. Cleere reported that the students have been doing case studies and community service activities and that the program has a healthy applicant pool. Faculty and students have been very busy in the dental clinic. Faculty Reports	Collins reported that she is teaching General Nutrition and Orofacial Anatomy and Histology with Dr. Greg Harrison. Henderson reported on 29 students, using blackboard and really likes it. Lester showed a power point presentation of dental hygiene projects for 2014. The students have participated in: Walk for Aids Awareness, Hablando health fair, oral screenings oral health education, Claude middle school, head start health fair, homeless health fair and City Church. Lester-Chisum reported on TalEval-more calibrated and helps in determining where students need remediation. Still learning the new process and software, but excited to see what all it can do. Hayhurst reported this semester the faculty are teaching ultrasonic instrumentation in preclinic lab. 29 students are doing very well. Also reported to committee that the parking lot that was needed, was completed. Dr. McEntire reported that all is good, feels very fortunate to have the dental hygiene program at Amarillo College.
