She explained some of the requirements contained in the Advisory Committee Handbook that was included in members' packets. Delane discussed need of a Committee Chair, Scott Harmon was appointed and called the meeting to order.
	Copies of curriculum rotations and the Technical Education Code of Conduct were included in members' packets. Delane mentioned that many classes are shared between the programs and explained what the new Technical Core was and the value it brings to the students.
Curriculum Decisions:	

Open Discussion: learning to what they are working on in their jobs. Several spoke up saying they would love to offer internships to students.  It was pointed out that sometimes our students get jobs before they finish their program, but then their employer encourages and works with them to allow them to finish school.
