| New Business: | Dale Davis called the meeting to order at 11:50. He asked for a motion to approve minutes from the December 14, 2017 meeting. Harry Hueston made a motion to approve the minutes, Dennis Rice seconded the motion, and motion was carried. | | |
| Education Report: | Hank provided the mandatory TCOLE Advisory Board Training to all members present. | | |
| PRLEA Update: | <p>The 115th Academy finished their 1st semester 5/11/17. There are 22 in the class (lost 1) 13 A's, 9 B's. They will be getting into the majority of the practical aspects of the academy during the 2nd semester. They will graduate August 24, 2017.</p> <p>116th Academy-Hank just started the interviewing process. So far, no agency letters requesting PRPC Scholarships have been received.</p> <p>With the Perkins Grant, academy got many new and needed items: mats, ropes, blue guns, handcuffs, training handcuffs, batons, and holsters.</p> <p>It is required for a person to have a passing TSI score to get into the academy if they do not have a degree or exemption. But, if they have been in the military, they are automatically exempt. There could be other special reasons they would not need to take the TSI. A motion was made to require TSI testing except where exempted by the law or college policy or with approval by the dean. Dennis Rice made motion and Bill McLean seconded the motion. The motion was carried.</p> <p>Hank provided a summary of our recent TCOLE evaluation and explained that the process was much more extensive than in the past, but that we did very well. He noted the areas for improvement, and a hard copy of the evaluation was shared with the Advisory Board.</p> | | |
