 - According to Linda Hendrick, AC has obtained a Disaster Plan for Technology that is NIMS compliant (National Incident Management Systems).

Special Report- Hereford Campus (Daniel Esquivel)

The students at the Hereford Campus appreciate being able to take a full range of classes in Hereford. This enables them to have a full college experience without driving to Amarillo.

Hereford Education Report Highlights

- The Hereford campus had an enrollment of 265 for the Fall semester and an enrollment of 340 for the current Spring. Both figures include CEU enrollees.
- More students are enrolling in workforce training
- 72% of all students are Hispanic (this matches the population of Hereford)
- The majority of students are female
- Most students are from Hereford but 10% are from Dimmitt and 4% are from Friona
- 40% are full-time students and 60% are part-time
- 100% or the classrooms are being used and the computer classroom is always booked
- The ITV room is being used more
- Due to the high enrollment and crowding at the Hereford campus, classes have been scheduled at Hereford High School, Hereford ISD Administrative building, Hereford High School CT lab, and the Hereford Community Center

- In workforce training, the Hereford Campus has provided training for the following:
 - Panda Ethanol
 - White Energy (ethanol)
 - Tejas Industries
- Panda training:
 - All trainees were given the TABE and a score at the 9th grade or higher level was required to enter training
 - Training took place from January 22, 2007 through February 25, 2007
 - 70 enrolled and 65 completed training
 - All completers are guaranteed an interview with Panda
 - Training was so popular that a second class will start on April 9, 2007 with 40-50 trainees
- White Energy training:
 - 45 White Energy employees will be trained in OSHA
 - 15-20 will receive training in HAZMAT
 - Training will take place in August 2007
 - Sandy Jefferson will provide the training
- Tejas Industries training:
 - 200 employees and 100 are Spanish-speakers
 - Training will be offered in Occupational English
 - Classes start March 20, 2007 and will meet for 12 weeks
- Fall 2007 Preview:
 - Adding new classes
 - General Education ITV courses (e.g. history, government)
 - ESL will have a new part-time instructor
- Hereford Campus Challenges:
 - Limited space
 - Need to increase courses necessary to complete degrees
 - Need to increase skilled labor certification programs

Old Business:
