## FACULTY EVALUATION COMMITTEE MINUTES March 26, 2009

Members considered this SACS statement:

"On-campus course evaluations are completed by students on a schedule determined by each department; distance education course evaluations are completed by students on a schedule determined by the eLearning department."

Members Bratcher, Harding, Johnson, Kopenits, Rowh and Shadbolt motioned and agreed to recommend that the revised tool be replicated within all DE courses and traditional classroom environments, and all agreed to endorse the delivery of student evaluations of faculty performance within the online environment each academic semester.

Members also endorsed the delivery of on-campus course evaluations to be completed by students on a schedule to be determined by each department.
