SPECIAL MEETING

The Meeting was called to order at 12:05 p.m. by Dr. Paul Proffer, Chairman of the Board of Regents, who welcomed all in attendance. A quorum was present.

CONSIDERATION OF THE TAX RATE FOR 2018

In accordance with provisions of Section 26.04 of the Texas Property Tax Code, the Randall County Tax Assessor/Collector published a legal notice on August 9, 2018, stating that the effective tax rate for the Amarillo Junior College District for 2018 is \$ 0.20642 per \$100 of assessed value. The rollback rate for the Amarillo Junior College District for 2018 published in the legal notice is \$ 0.21651 per \$100 of assessed value.

Section 26.05 of the Property Tax Code requires a taxing unit to hold two public hearings on a tax rate if the recommended tax rate for the year exceeds the lower of the rollback tax rate or the effective tax rate. The recommended tax rate is \$ 0.20750.

Mr. Mize moved, seconded by Dr. Woodburn, that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.20750, which is effectively a 0.52% increase in the tax rate. The motion carried unanimously.

SET THE DATE TO ADOPT THE TAX RATE FOR 2018 AND SCHEDULE TWO PUBLIC HEARINGS REGARDING THE TAX RATE FOR 2018

The Board set the date to adopt the tax rate for 2018 and scheduled two public hearings regarding the tax rate for 2018.

Ms. Jennings moved, seconded by Mr. Mize, that the Board set the dates for two public hearings on the proposed tax rate for August 28, 2018, at 5:45 p.m., and September 11, 2018, at 12:00 noon in the Palo Duro Room on the Washington Street Campus, and that the Board set the date to adopt the 2018 tax rate for September 25, 2018, at 7:00 in the Palo Duro Room on the Washington Street Campus. The motion carried unanimously.
