Director's Report	 Rocsko reported: 100% pass rates for summer graduates, they are all working. There are a couple of curriculum changes: Radiopharmacy area tend to score lower, lab time will be added to the class next semester. All approved. 60 hr. curriculum students next semester they will be the ones who have gone through start to finish. Amarillo College, Tarrant County Community College, Houston Community College and Galveston Community College we are making a request to the State of Texas to have 6 hours added back to the program. The accrediting body have also sent a letter supporting that as well and we need more hours so we can meet the standards that goes into effect for 2018. Because of the 60 hours curriculum students going into the Capstone course they are losing clinical time. In the Capstone they will have lab time added to make up as much of the lost clinical time as possible. All approved. Mark Rowh asked which area you want to add the credit hours to. Rocsko stated probably practicum courses.

Director's Report	 The Committee approved and support programs request to the State of Texas to add 6 hours to curriculum. The first year students were coming 3 days a week and second year students were coming 2 days a week. In the spring it's going to be like that because of their 1 hour Practicum course. It's better for the 1st year students to come Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. 2nd year students Monday and Tuesday in the spring we flip that I have to see how it works and if we get more hours we might flip back. Lubbock Clinical site – Kayla goes once a month to check on the students. We have two students one at UMC and one at Covenant. The Accreditation only approved 2 for Covent and 1 for UT. We are going to Pantex on November 28th. Students sold enough T-shirts to pay for their portion of the trip to Dallas in April. First year students did some community service at the Down Town Women Center. Both cohorts are donating canned foods to the Acts community center senior snack pack program for senior citizens. Amarillo College trying to get our success initiative for the students to 70% completion by 2020. We have gone from 19% to 41% completion. 	Tamra Rocsko
