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Director Report	<p>Currently there are 22 sophomores and 23 freshmen, 19 are on track to complete the program in July 2017. Hart showed a power point with the Outcomes Assessment Data-Goals:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Goal 1: Monitor Program Effectiveness Starting in SP 2017 starting utilizing Developmental Testing Program for Radiography, published by St. Catherine University from Minneapolis, MN • Goal 2: Graduates will be clinically competent Everything acceptable except for one exam in the capstone course (RADR 2235)-Recommendation: Emphasis position relationships, critical thinking, and image correction techniques in RADR 1313 and RADR 1250 • Goal 3: Graduates will display communications skills Everything acceptable, but did add a Case Study assignment to the first year students that had them utilize patient interview skills and critical thinking when I added various situations to the interview process-I think it went well, but will modify some for next cohort • Goal 4: Graduates will display critical thinking/problem-solving skills Everything acceptable, many of these are measured off of the Clinical Evaluation, so accuracy when completing these is paramount • Goal 5: Graduates will exhibit professional development Everything acceptable, have added a modality paper to RADR 1201 and RADR 2309 to help students explore various modalities <p>Including program completers, ARRT pass rates, student satisfaction, employer satisfaction, and employment rate. Hart discussed the Curriculum, new 64 hour curriculum started in Fall of 2016. The cohort starting this fall will have a May 2018 completion, versus the July completion time frame. JCERT site visit: June 30 and July 1, 2016 received Accreditation for Five years. Computed Tomography – Planning for a FY 2018-2019 start for program. In the meantime, we are providing 16 CE credits that satisfy the ARRT requirement for structured education.</p>	Michael Hart
