Current information from Bureau of Labor Statistics – Employment of Dental Hygienists is projected to grow 20 percent from 2016 to 2026.

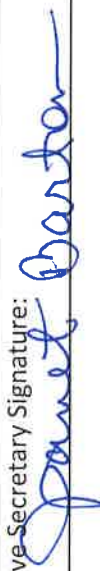

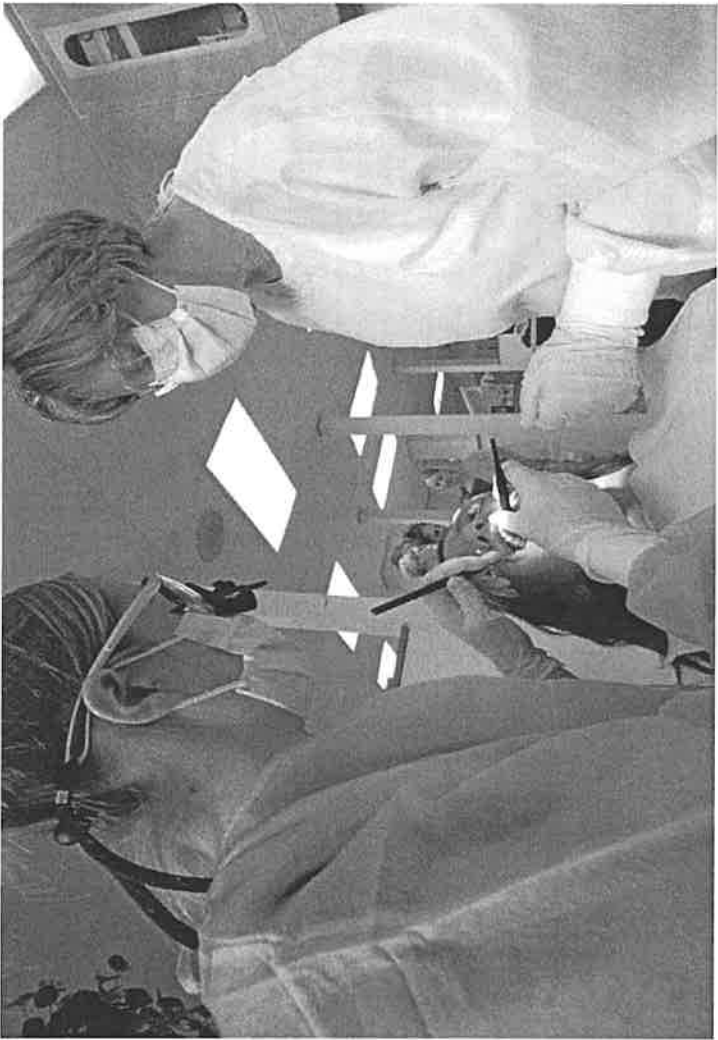

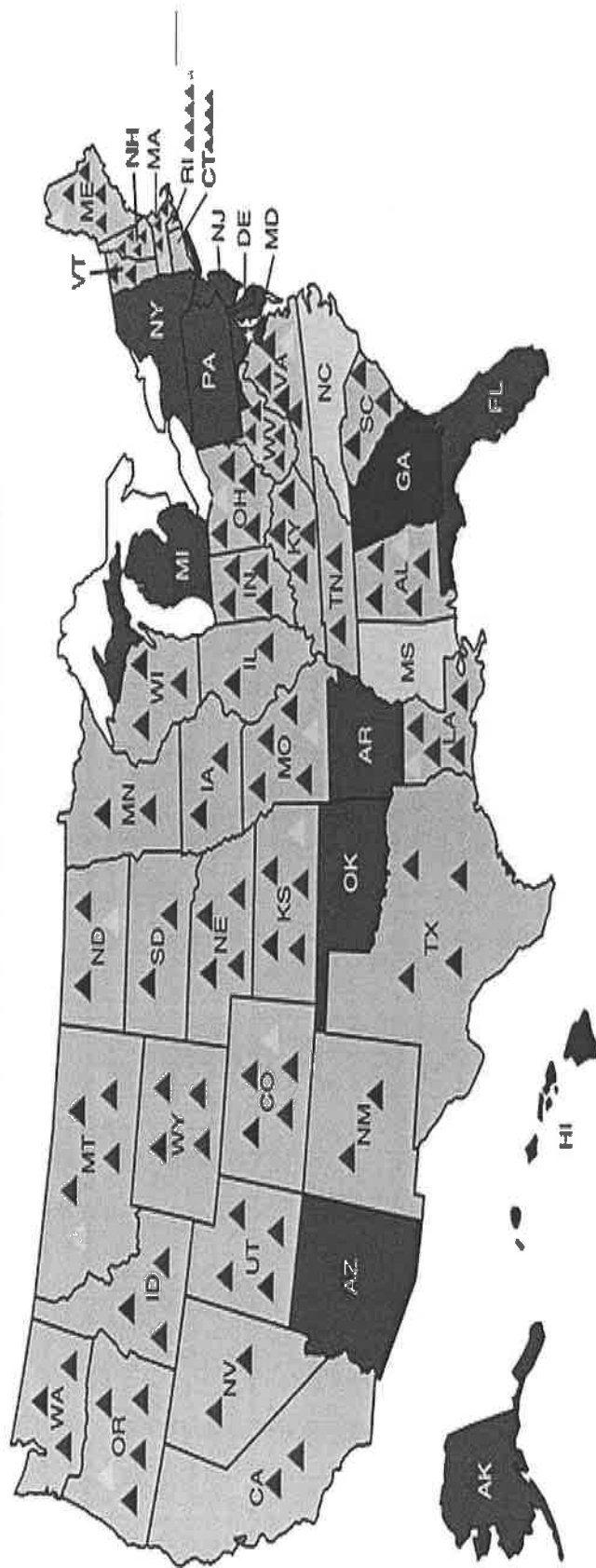
