Director's Report	*Tamra talked about pass rates. Hoped they would be 100%. They are at They are above accreditation benchmark (80%) at 89%. Accreditation does not set pass rates. *There is 100% job placement for students who graduate and pass exam. *Concern about pass rate and the 8-week Capstone course. Went to 16 week thinking that would be better. 16 weeks was more stressful for the students because they were given more tests and had more time to stress. In an effort to help students, they come to campus every week, have a quiz every day and have 4-6 mock exams through the semester. Students have to turn in Components of Preparedness each semester. Tamra meets one-on-one with students to review their components. Can use this as a study guide for Boards. Felt everything they did last year would ensure students would pass board exams. 2 failed which dropped the pass rates to 81% for that year. Trying new things to relieve stress. Grade 77.5 is passing, can only fail one exam. * Change in curriculum – AC only college in Texas using General Physics and Nuclear Med. Physics for the Nuclear Med. program. Tamra found out we can eliminate both General Physics and Nuclear med. Physics if we add the Allied Health Physics Course. This will take 3 hours from Pre-reqs, which could be used towards Nuclear Med. courses. Tamra will be asking the State for more hours. Currently at 60. Tamra asked for a vote from the members. Vote was taken by show of hands. All approved of dropping current physics courses and adding Allied Health Physics. * Change in student clubs – Student Life now has to track everything the clubs do. They want to find out if there is a correlation between participating and a student's success in their classes.
