Currently get approximately 100 applications for 20 positions. Sandra mentioned we no longer offer sports and exercise class, may help with applications. Pass and Employment Rates (See Presentation) Students can find jobs in our area. 4 students have taken board exam and 3 passed. Last year 11 out of 18 passed first time. Most have passed on 2nd try. There was a discussion about concerns about 3nd party payers sources for PTA services, specifically Medicare/Medicaid.
