TO MEET THE OBJECTIVES FOR RNSG 1248, THE STUDENT WILL DO THE FOLLOWING:	TO ASSIST STUDENTS TO MEET THE OBJECTIVES FOR RNSG 1248, THE INSTRUCTOR WILL DO THE FOLLOWING:
<p>Be punctual for classroom (didactic) instruction, conferences, and laboratory experiences.</p> <p>Attend at least <u>90%</u> of classroom meetings.</p> <p>Prepare for class by completing all assignments prior to class.</p> <p>Achieve a cumulative average of 70% or above on classroom exams.</p> <p>Take a make-up exam within one week of a regularly scheduled exam (prior to next class meeting). Make-up exams may be comprised of multiple choice and/or essay questions.</p> <p>Individual students may see their responses on an exam within one week of the exam being reviewed in class by the instructor. Students wanting to review their individual responses need to schedule an appointment with the instructor.</p>	<p>Be in classroom for didactic instruction at scheduled times.</p> <p>Provide a multiple choice, essay, and/or short answer make-up exam for students absent from a scheduled exam.</p> <p>Post office hours for student conferences.</p> <p>Provide lab supervision for demonstration of competencies.</p> <p>Provide a competency deficiency form designed to assist the student for retesting.</p>
TO MEET THE OBJECTIVES FOR RNSG 2261, THE STUDENT WILL DO THE FOLLOWING:	TO ASSIST STUDENTS TO MEET THE OBJECTIVES FOR RNSG 2261, THE INSTRUCTOR WILL DO THE FOLLOWING:
<p>Demonstrate proficiency in lab competencies.</p> <p>Achieve 100% on the Dosage and Solution Exam with no more than two repeats prior to the clinical experience.</p> <p>Be punctual for clinical and clinical simulation experiences.</p> <p>Attend 100% of clinical and clinical simulation experiences.</p> <p>Notify the instructor of clinical absence prior to pre-clinical conferences. Failure of proper notification of an absence may result in a failure of the clinical course even if a student is progressing well in other aspects of clinical performance.</p> <p>Make up all clinical absences in order to meet the clinical course objectives. No more than two days may be made up due to illness or other unexpected circumstances. Absences due to work schedules or vacations will not be excused.</p> <p>Satisfactorily complete all clinical competencies.</p> <p>Present NCP prior to receiving report on assignment client(s). Incomplete care plans may constitute a clinical absence.</p> <p>Present Clinical Summary Analysis Paper on assigned date and time. If a paper is not submitted to the instructor at all, the student will fail the clinical course.</p> <p>Recognize that faculty member must be present in the clinical agency for direct care given to clients.</p> <p>Maintain agency and client confidentiality at all times, which include verbal, written, and electronic sources of information.</p> <p>Abide by all policies in the Associate Degree Nursing Student Handbook.</p>	<p>Evaluate the Nursing Care Plan (NCP) and required papers and assignments. If the NCP is not satisfactory, it will be returned to the student for correction. The Clinical Summary Analysis Paper is submitted only ONE TIME for grading.</p> <p>Be in clinical area as scheduled. Help students select a variety of clients to enrich the learning experience.</p> <p>Evaluate student progress in the clinical area.</p> <p>Note: Deviation from the student contract will be evaluated on an individual basis with the clinical instructor, Level III Team Coordinator, and Nursing Division Chair.</p> <p>FACULTY WILL NOT ACCEPT PERSONAL GIFTS FROM STUDENTS.</p>
