1. CC minutes from 10.11.18 approved
2. DevEd RDNG – DevEd submitted a petition to delete RDNG 0302 in response to HB 2223 and the state’s requirement therein to push increasingly toward a corequisite model whereby developmental students enroll in an exit-level developmental AND a transfer-level course. RDNG 0302 is not an exit-level developmental course and thus cannot count toward the required percentage of corequisite students, which must eventually reach 75%. Without RDNG 0302, another petition was submitted to lower the TSI placement score for INRW 0303. A representative from the English Department expressed concern with the deletion but noted that there were no other workarounds that had been found to address the HB 2223 corequisite requirement. A motion was made and seconded. The petitions were approved.
3. BUSI ADMIN – BSET petitioned to allow a blanket substitution for SPCH 1321 or SPCH 1315 with SPCH 1318. SPCH 1321 or 1315 is a requirement in the BUSI ADMIN degrees. However, many students who were on another degree track, before changing to a BUSI ADMIN degree, completed SPCH 1318. Objections were raised about a possible loss of revenue in not requiring these students to complete SPCH 1321 or 1315, as well as the applicability of SPCH 1318 in a BUSI ADMIN degree. The petitioner noted that these students would not take the other SPCH courses at AC anyway, as transfer institutions like WTAMU already accept SPCH 1318. A motion was made and seconded. The petition was approved.
4. Fees – General & Lab – The chair pointed out that future petitions proposing changes to existing fees must be approved by the Board of Regents. Petitions in which fees are added to programs should correspond to the published fees on the AC website.
