IT and HR have been testing Cornerstone for the compensation task deployment in September. The data is not consistent and they have been unable to isolate the programming problem. This accelerated the decision to create matrix-based criteria for performance value ratings.

Much discussion took place and a suggestion was made to allow managers to use the same procedures as the past two years since they understand their own scoring methods. Ms. Jones stated that if this is to be done it will need to be done soon because there are only a few weeks before budgets are due.

Because scoring methods are inconsistent, Dr. Lowery-Hart requested that Ms. Jones reevaluate the matrix based on the average scoring for each Vice President's division and create a matrix for each division.
