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	4.2 Level II – T. Rhodes – Level 2 has a total of 85 students. <u>Med Surg –</u> Specialty Exam given yesterday (11/27/18). The results were impressive with a mean score of 877. Scores ranged from 530-1146. Conversion scores ranged from 53.19- 95.77. This is a custom exam, therefore there is no national average score. Students are beginning required remediation according to program policy. Course instructors are analyzing the results to address area of weakness. This is 5 % of the grade and has not been added to the gradebook at this time. Module 3 given on 11/21/18, Total 66 Students Sect 1- 35 Students, Average 81.26, 1 question was nullified A's=3 B's=20 C's=8 D's=4 (68, 72, 74, 74) Currently 2 are not passing the course (Averages 72 & 74) Sect 2-31 Students, Average 83.17, 1 question nullified A's=6 B's=18 C's=4 D's 3 (70, 72, 74) Currently 3 students are not passing the course (Averages 73-74) Final Exam is Monday, December 10th. (6 accommodations- These cannot be accommodated in the Testing Center. Testing for these students will be done in empty faculty offices.) <u>Transition-</u> Currently 13 students All students are currently passing the course.
