# **SPECIAL MEETING**

The meeting was called to order at 4:04 p.m. by Mr. Johnny Mize, Chairman of the Board of Regents. Mr. Mize welcomed those in attendance. A quorum was present.

#### **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

There were no public comments.

#### **TAX RATE FOR 2020 PROPOSED**

In accordance with provisions of Section 26.06 of the Texas Property Tax Code, Amarillo College will publish a legal notice on August 17, 2020, stating that the no-new-revenue tax rate for the Amarillo Junior College District for 2020 is \$ 0.22304 per \$100 of assessed value. The voter-approval tax rate for the Amarillo Junior College District for 2020 published in the legal notice is \$ 0.25320 per \$100 of assessed value.

Section 26.05 of the Property Tax Code requires a taxing unit to hold one public hearing on a tax rate if the recommended tax rate for the year exceeds the lower of the voter-approval tax rate or the nonew-revenue tax rate. The recommended tax rate is \$ 0.22790.

Mr. Mize read the proposed tax rate. There was no discussion.

Mrs. Carlisle moved, seconded by Dr. Proffer, that the proposed tax rate not exceed \$0.22790 which will effectively be a 2.17% increase in the tax rate. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Miller moved, seconded by Mr. Henke, to set the date for the public hearing and adoption of the proposed tax rate for August 25, 2020 at 6:45 p.m., in the Oak Room on the Washington Street Campus. Motion carried unanimously
