About 1000 registered recently. 2 nd year students are enrolled and ready to go. 1 st year students can register at any time. Jessica Sanchez – Jessica introduced herself. Student Report	Myrka Lino 2 nd year— have issues with patients canceling due to COVID. Having a hard time finding patients due to the pandemic. Need adolescent age group. Dental Hygiene started a clinical on Wednesday night which has helped. There was discussion about going to the Mall to recruit patients. Josie Brown 1 st year — being in the Dental Hygiene classes is different. The curriculum is hard. Small class. Only taking three classes this semester instead of four. Director's Report	Donna Cleere – (see PowerPoint Presentation) Donna stated her applicant pool for this year was 113. They took 14 students from an applicant pool of 113. Accreditation Site Visit 2017 – No recommendations. Full Accreditation without reporting requirements. Next site visit will be in 2025. All site visits will be delayed for 1 year due to the COVID-19 pandemic. October 2020 Annual Accreditation report was completed and sent to CODA. Also sent the Interruption of Education report and Use of Distance Education Report from changes due to COVID 19. Both reports were accepted by CODA. Donna reported on Completion – Pass Rates. 92% passed written Board exam, 100% passed Clinical Board Exam. During a year like this, it is amazing to have 100% pass rate on the clinical board. Amarillo College maintains an excellent pass rate for both the National Board and the Clinical Board Exams. COVID IMPACT – Thankful for equipment we have received. Mitzi Leonard did a great job making sure we had supplies and equipment we needed. Did not have any shortages. Donna stated Dr. Modery made masks for the Dental Hygiene and Dental Assisting programs. Both programs are very thankful for his generosity. Social Distancing - Reduced the number of students and patients in the clinic per session. Put Plexi Glass barrier in the front office. Have an Infection Control Supervisor, Use N-95 masks as well as level 3 masks and face shields along with the other PPE. Placed air filters in the operatory and hallways. This past summer held clinic around the clock including Saturday and Sunday. Limited number of students in classroom and labs. Used Tech supported instruction via Blackboard Collaborate. 	New Equipment Received Intra Oral Camera – DEXcam 4 – have 5, getting 2 more for a total of 7 Digital Impression Camera – Trios 4 – Assists in teaching students the latest technology in taking impressions, and the art of scanning. Velscope – used for the detection of premalignant and malignant lesions of the oral cavity.

Affiliation Reports	LaVon Barrett – LaVon invited Myrka to visit the nursing classes to recruit students for patients. Kasmir Perez – Dr. Coury – Kasmir stated their office stayed open with COVID. Taking precautions. Started using Gentle Wave Technology Carrie Jaramillo – Head Start – It is a challenge keeping kids in class using virtual classes. She is connecting families with medical and dental services. They have received a lot of community help. Brie Brooks – Dr. Vaughan – Brie stated they were busy in the summer. Patients have been willing to come in despite COVID. Dr. McEntire – Dr. McEntire thanked the staff and students for stepping up during this time in a pandemic. Has 2 people in his office in quarantine. They hired a couple of students from AC to fill in and he is very pleased with their work. Dr. McEntire stated he enjoyed the zoom meeting. This was his first one. Dr. Modery – Dr. Modery stated his office did not get hit hard with COVID. Had to send first staff member home recently. Have not had staff to patient or patient to staff infections. Using Chlorohexidine for periodontal scrubs. It is cheaper than laser. Chelsea Odell – Advanced Dentistry – Kudos to staff and students for their hard work. Great teamwork and dedication. Chelsea stated the clinic had some slow times. Patients are starting to come in. Amanda mentioned that Chelsea, Erica and Charlene helped out in the evening in the Dental Clinic during the summer. It was a big help.	
Dean of Health Sciences Report	Kim Boyd – Kim commended the Dental Hygiene group for everything they are doing to keep patients and students safe. We are starting to get more COVID cases. Kim spoke for Barbara Wahi who is Director of Perkins Grant. She mentioned the Perkins	

	grant is how we get most of the equipment we have. Our Advisory Board meetings are a part of this. We need to know what equipment is needed to better educate our students. Hopefully in the spring we will be able to hold a Mega Advisory Board meeting. More information will come out about that. Kim talked about the College closing at 1:00 the next few Fridays.	
Faculty Report	Amanda Lester-Chisum – Have had COVID within Faculty, Staff, and Students in the dental area. Have not had any cases thru the Clinic. They work very hard to be safe. Students have been diligent with infection control, make sure they are social distancing. Have had patients' no-show or cancel possibly due to COVID. Dr. Modery mentioned that the Dental Community is in the fore front of infection control. Lynette Hayhurst – Lynette reported on her Orofacial Anatomy Class- Students have learned general anatomical terms pertaining to the extra oral/intraoral cavity, embryology and the formation of the oral tissues and the development of the teeth. We have reviewed and discussed all of the permanent teeth and the students will have a tooth ID practical the first week in December. To finish up the semester, we will learn the ins and outs of the periodontium, and finally review the skeletal system, muscles of mastication/facial expression, 12 cranial nerves, and the circulatory system. (Lynette's information was added after the meeting) Dr. Henderson – Dr. Henderson thanked the Dentists for helping our community. Dr. Henderson mentioned several dentists have left AC. Dr. Harrison retired, Dr. Miller went back to private practice and Dr. Sparkman helps out when he can. Dr. Dunham and several others help when they can. Dr. Modery asked if we need to put feelers out for help. Dr. Henderson stated that right now we are ok. Staggering the schedule has helped but if anyone wants to help out we welcome it. Clinic and Dental Materials is going well. Students are serious about their classes and clinics. He stated he feels safe but it is different with COVID. The Trios 3D Scanner will change dentistry. We have a new 3D Scanner. Dental Assisting has been using it. Stated it is amazing. The Velscope is good also. Will utilize


