Accreditation: The accreditation is in the process of having programs change to an AAS program only. We are in the process of teaching out the certificate program. The last certificate program will begin in fall 2020

The NBSTSA has implemented a change in the scoring of the National Certification Exam from 118 to 102. The rigor will not change. The overall national exam rate is 72%-74% passing rate.

The accreditation has implemented a temporary focus on case number and not clinical hour. They are working diligently to be flexible during the COVID crises. A total of 120 cases is still required. As the student reaches 120 cases in accordance with the standard, they will satisfy the requirements.
