This will be demonstrated by the completion of an anonymous pre and post survey (test).	1. The difference between pre and post scores were not satistically significant. It appears the student's did not become less ethnocentric after completing the Behavioral Science courses.	1. Analysis – Data collected came from two sources with a small sampling.
