This data covers the graduating class of 2007 (May 11, 2007 - May 10, 2008)</p> <p>Standard: 80% of the students will pass the NR exam wthin one year after graduation</p>	1. 100% (9/9) of the students passed the NR certification exam within one year of graduation.	<p>1. Anaylsis: Standard was exceeded by 20% with 100% of the students passing the NR exam within one year of graduation. Note: National average for the same time period was 80%.</p> <p>Plan: Revise the benchmark to 85% to exceed the national average. Add a capstone course in the final semester to better prepare the student for the NR certification examination.</p>

2. Guide students to pass the NR certification examination on the first attempt.

2. Tool:
YTD results from NR certification examinations are available to the program Director online. The Director will assess the student first attempt pass rates annually. This data covers the graduating class of 2007 (May 1, 2007 - May 1, 2008)

Standard:
65% of the students will pass the NR examination on the first attempt.

2. 44% (4/9) of the students passed the NR certification exam on the first attempt

2. Analysis:
Standard was not met by 21% since only 44% of the student's taking the examination passed on the first attempt.
Note: National average first attempt pass rate was 61% for the same time period.

Plan:
Add a capstone course in the final semester to better prepare the student for the NR certification examination.

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
