Standard: 85% of the students will be able to pass the exit exam administered during the final Summer semester with a score of 70% or better.	1. 13 of 16, or 81.3% of the students passed. All 3 students who failed ad-mitted, in an instructor/ student conference, that they did not study for the exam. In the previous year 9 of 13 students taking the exit exam did pass.	Last years pass rate will be considered this year when administering the exam. Greater emphasis will be placed on encouraging students to study ALL material covered in the exam. Students will be given the opportunity to make arrangements with the program director to discuss any deficiencies that could aid in successfully passing the exam. A study session was offered to all students as a study aid.
2. Assist students with development of the skills necessary for performing specific administrative duties in various medical settings.	1. Tool: Practicum evaluation of the student's performance at the end of the program. Standard: 100% of the students will demonstrate proficiency in the performance of the basic entry level skills necessary for a Medical Data Specialist, with an over all score of 70% or better.	1. 100% of the students achieved an over all score of 70% or better.
