	Meeting. The purpose of the meeting is to get feedback from all of our clinical	
	sites on how we can better educate our students and the most current	
	procedures and equipment that is use in the facilities so we really need to have	
	as many representatives from our advisory board members as possible.	
	2 nd item is COMPLIO. This is the new company we are using for background	
	checks, drug screes and immunizations. The immunization pieces allows	
	students to upload their immunizations. At the end when they graduate the	
	students will have lifetime access to their immunizations and so they'll be able	
	access the information at any time.	
	Another new thing that's coming next year, is the HESI exam. A few programs	
	piloted it this year, and plan on all of our health science majors using the exam	
	next year. The areas that we're testing our math, anatomy and physiology,	
	reading and critical thinking. Kim stated the reason we want to use the HESI is	
	when we have a student who is weaker in certain areas we want to get them	
	help before they are really struggling in the program. The critical thinking is	
	something that all of our advisory boards have stated is needed.
