DISCUSSION:

1. GALLUP EMPLOYEE ENGAGEMENT SURVEY RESULTS Mr. Hodges stated that 78% of workers worldwide are not reaching their full potential and are not engaged. Actively disengaged employees are unhappy at work and resentful that their needs are not met. Additionally, they are potentially undermining their engaged coworkers' accomplishments. How engaged employees feel today gauges how they will perform in the future. A thriving workplace is the responsibility of leaders, managers, and supervisors. Gallup is helping organizations build sustained engagement. Employees who love their job are engaged. Less than 12% of Amarillo College employees are currently not engaged.

After reviewing the survey results for Amarillo College, Mr. Hodges stated this is a baseline. Next year's results will provide more insight.
