Denese Skinner reported the number of users significantly increased for Timely MD in December and continues to grow as students learn that Amarillo College provides the service. The average wait time to virtually see a doctor using Timely MD is eight minutes, and it's 4 minutes for an emergency triage counseling service. A virtual counselor typically takes eight days to see a patient if it's not an emergency.

Joe Bill Sherrod reported that a lot of donations were made to the college during Christmas break. Over \$1.2M was raised from November 1, 2022-December 31, 2022, during our year-end appeal. The Badger Bold Campaign total is \$32,286,693. This includes donations from September 1, 2020-December 31, 2022.

The 3% raises will be on the January 27, 2023 paycheck.
