Mr. Austin reported that Academic Affairs, Student Enrollment, and Enrollment Management divisions have been working with the vendor EduNav for the last nine months. EduNav is an academic planning, degree discovery, and mobility solution that empowers informed decision-making.

Mr. Olmos reported that advising is currently using Ellucian for student planning. He shared that Ellucian requires everything related to degree audits to be entered manually. EduNav automatically performs a degree audit for each student and updates it in real time. Additionally, it allows the students to pick times and dates in the calendar that will work with their schedule, then the software will recommend classes that best fit their schedule. Additionally, students cannot accidentally choose classes outside of their degree plan. If a course is dropped, the software will automatically add it to the next semester, and a warning will be issued regarding prolonging graduation.
