Bob Austin reported overall enrollment for the entire college is up 2%, and contact hours are up 3.8% compared to last year. Hereford enrollment has increased, and West Campus enrollment decreased due to programs closing. East Campus and Moore County Campus enrollments are comparable to last year. Increasing enrollment continues to be a challenge due to covid. The economy is another challenge the college faces. Currently, there are 1,311 students enrolled in Dual Credit.
