Health Science Advisor Report	Jessica Sanchez stated she has been meeting with students making sure they have everything ready and green lighting them. Jessica stated Dental is good to go.	
Student Report	Aubrey Bellino 1 st year (student President) – learning hand instruments, Nutrition, Oral Facial, Dental Materials, and porcelains. Aubrey stated it is a lot of fun. Rylee Moore 2 nd year student – Rylee stated she is ready to finish. She has been working on the Mock Boards. Rylee mentioned it is nice to have the same instructors for Dental Hygiene Care II and Preventative Care. Rylee said they also get to play fun games.	
Director's Report	Amanda Lester-Chisum (for Donna Cleere) – Amanda showed a picture of the last small class from the COVID Era. Dental Hygiene is now back to 24 students. Amanda reviewed the Amarillo College Strategic Plan – 80% completion rate by 2025. Focus is on IDS completion Goal, Degree Alignment, Learning, Equity and Financial. Amanda reported on Amarillo College being a winner of the Aspen Prize Top Community College in the Nation for 2023! Board Exams – Students take two exams – one clinical and one written. AC students also take the CRDTS exam which is accepted in most states. Board Clinicals – Students achieved 100% pass rate. Overall average was 97.4%. National Written Boards – students achieved 92.8% pass rate. There was one failure. The student re-took the exam and passed on the second attempt. Accreditation – Next site visit will be in 2025. Donna and Amanda are working on the Self Study now. The October 2023 Annual Accreditation Report was completed and sent to CODA. New in the Dental Hygiene Program – We received Perkins Grant Funds to purchase the following: 25 cavitrons, one DXTTR X-ray Manikin Trainer (this is on its way), Nomad Portable X-ray Unit, Midwest Hand pieces, Cassettes, and Miele Dental Instrument Washer. Amanda reported that the Dental Hygiene program will be getting a new Clinical Lab Instructor: Kara Webb. She received her Bachelor's degree from the University of Oklahoma and followed by her Associate Degree in Dental Hygiene from AC in 2012. She has worked full-time in general dentistry for 11 years. Amanda mentioned that help is needed with filling four (4) part-time DH Instructor positions. Bachelor's degree is required (New Accreditation Standard




