Under the supervision of a licensed irrigator, the Irrigation Technician will install, maintain, alter, repair, service or supervise the installation of irrigation systems. The 16-hour class includes water conservation definitions, components, design, installation, maintenance, and the rules and regulations of the state of Texas. The class includes the new “Texas Landscape Irrigation Training and Reference Manual” used by 70% of Texas Professional Irrigation Trainers.
