Selden B. Hale has trained at the USMC Weapons Training Battalion at Camp Matthews and Infantry Training Regiment at Camp Pendleton, California. He has completed FBI Pistol Course. Selden is a court qualified firearms expert and a TCLEOSE Firearms Instructor. He has trained at Thunder Ranch seven times, including pistol, shotgun and team tactics. Additional training includes the TDCJ Close Quarters, the AC Law Enforcement Rapid Response, Suarez International's Urban Rifle, Close Quarters Pistol, Shotgun Courses and the APD SWAT Pistol Course. He served as a Principal Firearms Instructor during TDCJ's PTSO Response Team course in 2001 and 2002. He taught a 3-day Prison Rapid Response Team course in Snyder in 2003.

Gerald Davis is a TDCJ-ID Master Firearms and C. Agent Instructor, Self-Defense Instructor and Certified Hostage Negotiator. He is a Certified TCLEOSE Firearms Instructor and is S.W.A.T. certified. He attended Thunder Ranch Revolver Training and is a "Close Quarter Battle" Instructor. He is a member of the Texas Tactical Officers Association and International Association of Law Enforcement Instructor. Major Davis served 11 years as Commander for Northern Region 5 Emergency Response Team and 19 years with TDCJ-ID Maximum Security. He served as the Training Major for Northern Region 5 at Plainview.

Course Objectives

Students will learn to operate and quickly present the shotgun in a tactical environment, including field applications, transportation, perimeter defense, and movement to and from hostile contact. The student will learn appropriate weapon nomenclature, firing stance, unloading/loading procedures. Firing will be at CQB distances in stressful conditions including prone positions. Shotguns will be provided with low recoil ammo compliments of the NRA..
