Long Range Rifle Course

Students are responsible for bringing a rifle that is capable of one MOA or better, with 500 rounds for the weapon.

Seminar Description

Long Range Rifle Engagement for the Law Enforcement Officer is a five-day course with 40 hours of TCLEOSE credit and is designed to increase officer marksmanship skills needed to obtain target identification and proper target engagement at extended ranges beyond 500 yards. Students should have basic marksmanship skills and proficiency with a sniper rifle including the operations of a rifle scope. Two ranges will be used, a known distance range course and an unknown distance range course with target range out to 1,000 yards. The student is responsible for bringing a rifle that is capable of one MOA or better, with 500 rounds for the weapon.

Target Audience

Federal and state law enforcement officers and contracted federal marksmanship instructors.

Instructors

Scott Cantu is an Amarillo, Texas native. He joined the Army and served with the 3/187 Infantry Regiment. While assigned to the 3/187, he went to Air Assault School, Ranger Induction Program, and S.O.T.I.C. Special Operations Identification Course. Soon after the events of 9/11, the unit was deployed to Afghanistan. He served with the RECON unit, and from there he was deployed to Iraq for the invasion. In Iraq, Scott served 9 months as a sniper before returning to the U.S. After returning to Amarillo, he worked for the Potter County Sheriff's Office, and later at the Pantex nuclear weapons plant as a Security Police Officer. From there, he opened LS Hunting and later started the LS Hunting School and SpearHead Tactical. These ventures have been growing for over 5 years now.

Randy Glass is a Bethlehem, Pennsylvania native. He enlisted in the US Marine Corps attending Marine Boot Camp in Parris Island, S.C. and was soon a member of 1st Battalion 2nd Marines, 2d MarDiv, Camp Lejeune N.C. Over the next four years, he served with PSD Security Platoon, Marine Special Purpose FORCE Platoon, Scout/Sniper Platoon, and was a Marine Infantry Squad Leader in Iraq. He has attended a host of military and post-military specialized training, ranging from advanced survival schools to advanced/urban/counter sniper courses. Randy is also a Nationally Certified EMT and is currently completing a degree in Biology from West Texas A&M University.
