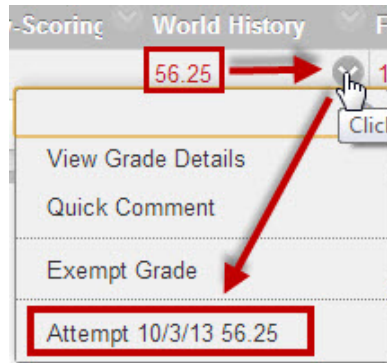


Use the **Test Access Log** to verify student activity during a test

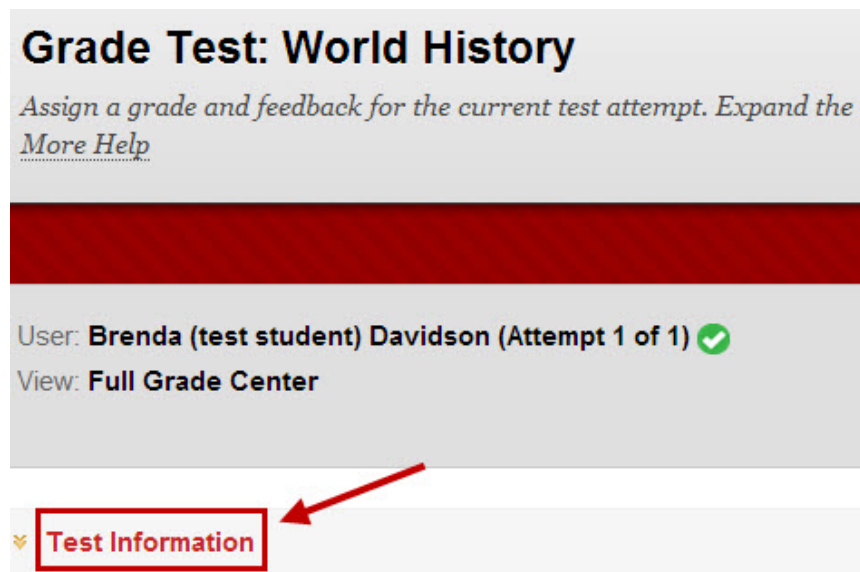
A new feature in Blackboard lets you verify student activity or lack of activity during a test. The new **Test Access Log** provides detailed information on student test attempt interactions.

Instructors can view the **Access Log** for a test from the **Attempts** page. Follow the steps below:


1. In the **Full Grade Center**, locate the test grade for which you want to view the **Access Log**.
2. Click the drop-down contextual menu for that test grade, and select **Attempt**.



3. Click on **Test Information** in the **Grade Test** page.

Instructions

- The **Access Log** shows a detailed list of every interaction that students engage in when taking a test. If a student claims to have started a test, the log will show the time the test was started. If a network or internet disruption occurred during the test for example, the log would show an unusual gap in the time.

Access Log

The **Test Time** column shows times relative to the start of the test and the **Time Spent** column shows the time between the current **Access Type** and the previous **Access Type**. Time format is: mm:ss.
