Elevating Engagement with Interactive Slide Decks for Student Learning

We often think of slide decks as a teaching tool that helps us organize and present information to our students. What if slide decks could be used as an interactive tool that gives students the opportunity to create and take ownership of their learning? With a few simple steps,you can create interactive slide decks that can be used in your Blackboard Ultra courses.

What are the benefits of using interactive slides with your students?

First, students can be creative and add their own voice and style when adding to the interactive deck. They are given basic instructions for what to include on their slides, but are given freedom to choose how they want to represent that information. Second, adding information to the slides is the responsibility of the students, and helps them take ownership of their learning. Next, these activities can be completed in collaborative groups where students can learn from their peers and talk through concepts. Finally, interactive slide decks can be used for a variety of activities making them a versatile add in for online and traditional courses.
